are offering you the opportunity to have your bikes  
SOUND TESTED before the 2006 season gets into full swing.

Over the weekend of Saturday March 25<sup>th</sup> and Sunday March 26<sup>th</sup> 2006  
Trained and Licensed Sound Officials will be checking machines to the latest ACU  
specification, and will be at Canada Heights, Button St, Swanley, Kent.

The testing will be open to ACU license holders only, from any centre or club. Sight  
of your license will be required on the day

There will be NO RIDING OF MACHINES, you will be allowed to warm the  
machine to riding temperature and present it for testing only. A charge of £5 per  
machine will be levied with all proceeds being donated to the ACU Benevolent Fund.  
You may bring along as many pipes and silencers as you wish and have the various  
combinations tested, the charge is for each bike not each silencer.

Please email Roger Brown to book a timed appointment, this way we can spread the  
load during the day and if necessary if the demand is high we can get extra Officials

turn up on the day then you may have a long wait as pre-booked people will have  
their machines tested first.
